Bursaries are our greatest fundraising priority, ensuring that bright young people from families of modest means can benefit from the special type of education provided at St Aloysius' College.

Each year in early February, our Bursary Committee meets to discuss Bursary applications. Donations of all sizes translate into places for those pupils whose need is greatest and regular gifts can make a big difference when planning ahead to award Bursary places.

Here are three of our most Frequently Asked Questions about Bursaries:

Q: Who Is on the College Bursary Committee?

A: There is a Bursary Committee of three Governors, together with the Head Master and Bursar who consider the applications after the Entrance Examination has taken place.

Q: How much is awarded to applicants?

A: Each case is taken on its own merits, but proof is required of any

family income and assets. Recipient families are means-tested on an annual basis. Almost all Bursary applicants receive a 100% award as this is what is needed for them to access an education at the College.

Q: What is the response to date for the Opportunity Fund for Bursaries?

A: Gifts and pledges worth £1.1M have been donated to Bursaries at the College so far. This includes two gifts left in Wills.
